3. Remarks on budget items.

Sally A: UBC overhead is now 25 %. The Big Tree Registry has found secure long term funding. Charlie C: WBP germination procedure now optimized (80% success) by Vicki, can be taught to a contractor, extra plant material available for sixth test site.

Dave K: WBP areas not yet covered by ex situ conservation are remote, require helicopter or collaboration with e.g. backcountry lodge association. For non-commercial species, where possible, collections for research purposes should be expanded to allow for some extra seed for ex-situ conservation. Coastal areas are well-covered by ex-situ collections, remaining needs are in the north-east. As seed collection for willows is difficult, perhaps we can use cuttings. Jack W: there is a reduction of 10% in the FGC budget overall.

4. In-person meeting in spring, 1.5 days long.

One day will be dedicated to Whitebark pine recovery strategy and a half day will be dedicated to progress updates on any other ongoing GCTAC work. Location: UBC. Date: May 2015. Pia will check speaker availability. Pia will check with Joanne Vinnedge to avoid overlap with a summer (August) field WBP workshop that she is organizing.
