2. FGC Membership

Keith reported Annette will be appointed Industry co-chair, and Lise van der Merwe, new Manager, Forest Genetics Section, as a Ministry representative. The appointment letters are currently in the chief forester's office. Two industry positions remain vacant.

4. Safety

Members were invited to report on any safety-related incidents or initiatives within the purview of FGC. No news or incidents were reported.

5. FGC and SelectSeed Dashboards

The FGC and SelectSeed dashboards were provided as Attachment B.

Brian reviewed changes since October. Noted were FGC's strategic plan reporting (see #10) and delays in completing SelectSeed's strategic plan, partner negotiations and property subdivision. Also noted was SelectSeed's projected deficit for fiscal 2024/25 due to a poor Pli crop and a significant drop in seed sales.

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The deficit could be partially mitigated if the ministry does not invoice SelectSeed for the full \$110k provided under their MoU and if BCTS/FIP purchase additional seed before the end of fiscal. Keith and Kona will consider these respective options.

Members also confirmed their interest in maintaining these dashboards.

6. Ministry budget and updates

Keith reported that the Ministry's land-base investment strategy (LBIS) is no longer internally managed as a separate account. LBIS funds were re-allocated to ministry and branch base budgets. The (former) LBIS allocation for FIRM's forest genetics section operations, excluding salaries, was reduced to \$1.7M in fiscal 2024/25.

In addition to its base budget, FIRM manages a cost-recovery account for its seed orchard and tree seed centre (non-stewardship) operations and receives additional funding from the ministry's forest carbon/climate change programs.

Albert provided an overview of the premier's Jan 16 <u>mandate letter</u> to Hon. Ravi Parmar, Minister of Forests. The minister's direction includes program reviews in collaboration with the ministry of finance. The letter also includes an annual harvest target of 45M m³, which is different from and lower than the current AAC of 61M m³ and higher than last year's actual harvest of 32M m³. Albert estimates this harvest level, plus the ministry's forest investment program (FIP), could sustain a provincial planting program of 300M seedlings/year, same # as the government's election promise.

7. Seedling needs forecast project update

As of January 16, approved seedling requests for 2025 sowing were ~200M, plus an additional 12M in pending status for 212M total. The current total is 20M seedlings fewer compared to the same period last year. Source: Tree Seed Centre.

Brian provided an update on the seedling needs forecast project, which will estimate annual seedlings requirements by species, BEC variant, MU, and funding source to 2054. The following steps will be completed by March 15, 2025:

- Review and clean data inputs, fill in MU gaps with expert reviews
- Add BCTS and FIP forecasts
- Add CCISS sensitivity analysis
- Compile, prepare report and provincial spreadsheet

The analysis is being done by Forsite Consulting under contract with SelectSeed. Total cost is projected to exceed the \$55k budget by ~\$8K. Brian will discuss funding contribution options with the ministry.

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Following the completion, FGC can advance challenge dialogue priority #2... "Develop a seed supply strategy that assesses current orchard capacity, identifies gaps, quick wins, and longer-term needs." This review will be undertaken in collaboration with ITAC, CTAC and others.

Action: Brian, Kat, Annette and Kevin to discuss process and timelines to review seed supply gaps and opportunities prior to completion of seedling needs forecast project.

8. ITAC extension and business meetings – Jan 15-16, 2025

Kat provided a summary of the ITAC extension meeting, which was attended by ~230 persons from across BC, Canada and the US on-line each day. The presentations over the 1.5 days included a mix of operational forestry and genetics research. Recordings of the presentations, with the exception of those by FIRM's genetics section staff, will be posted on the ITAC webpage later. Lise will provide a summary report of the ministry's breeding programs later in the spring.

Kat reported several changes to ITAC membership. Discussions at the business meeting included need for clarification regarding setting priorities and the Ministry's process for releasing new materials and seed orchards. This request was passed along to the Ministry's policy group.

The following motion was also approved at the ITAC business meeting: FGC to produce a report on the economic benefits of tree improvement. It was subsequently noted there are few recent papers on this topic are available, including "Economic gain of genetically-selected coastal Douglas-fir" by Isaac-Renton et al, <u>Forest Policy and</u> <u>Economics 171 (2025) 103397</u>.

Action: Lise to provide updated breeding program Gantt charts for the April 9 meeting.

Action: Kat, Lise and Bevin to review ITAC's request for an economic benefits of tree improvement report and recommend next steps.

Action: Brian to post article "Economic gain of genetically-selected coastal Douglas-fir." on FGC website ASAP.

9. FGC extension – subcommittee report and priorities

Kathy Swift joined the meeting for this agenda item. She reviewed the latest version of the FGC extension map, which identifies target audiences, existing extension products/services and gaps/needs.

Action items from FGC's Dec. 6 meeting above, with additional considerations and ideas:

- First nations listen, understand values, needs and concerns first
- Invite FNs to upcoming FGC/TAC meetings and field tours (ongoing)

- Podcasts vs videos for wide outreach
- Products: forest genetics calendar, bookmarks
- Provide links to relevant initiatives & publications to FGC e-Newsletter
- Provide video to explain Dashboard use (following review & updates after seedling needs forecast report completed) early summer
- Seed orchard crop projection reports for seed users issued early summer

It was also recognized that many persons in the forest genetics community provide extension services as part of their regular duties e.g. hosting tours at seed orchards and research stations, interviews. Collecting these statistics may be useful, but onerous.

Kat, Annette, Juergen, Kathy and Brian met several times to develop a new forest genetics diagram. A draft concept was shared at the meeting. Further improvements are required before a draft is ready for review by FGC and others.

Except for advancing FN engagement, they recommended the forest genetics diagram be completed before FGC pursue other extension initiatives.

10. FGC Strategic Plan 2021-2025

Keith raised the need to review FGC's 2021-25 strategic plan and prepare another plan for the next five years. See <u>Strategic Plan</u> attachment D. It was recommended FGC's goals, objectives and performance measures should be reviewed and progress reported before commencing work on a new strategic plan for the period 2026-2030.

It was recommended that broad input, including from Canadian Forest Service, be solicited while preparing the next plan to improve buy-in and success with implementation.

Action: Keith, Annette, Kat, Lise and Brian to develop plan for reviewing FGC's current strategic plan and preparing the next one – by April 9.

11. SelectSeed AGM and director elections

The SelectSeed Directors Policies approved by FGC on May 28, 2024, require a nomination committee be struck four months in advance of the AGM. See attachment E.

SelectSeed's AGM is scheduled for Thursday, June 19. Jack Woods' and Sally John's terms as the company directors end on this date. They will confirm their interest in standing for re-appointment before the end of March.

Action: Keith, Annette and Dan M. to convene a directors' nomination committee and invite a representative from SelectSeed before the end of February.

12. News and announcements

Dan M. announced the Canadian Wood Fibre Centre (CWFC) will be dissolved effective April 1, 2025. CWFC staff and programs will be integrated into the Canadian Forest Service (CFS) and its regional offices.

The CFS, SelectSeed (on behalf of FGC), VSOC and PRT are sponsors of the IUFRO 7.03.11 Resistance Mechanisms and Breeding workshop to be held in Vernon, June 1-6. See link below.
